**Deposit** A deposit is required before the start of the child's entry to the school. The amount of the deposit is detailed on the previous page and will be retained in the general funds of the School until the pupil leaves. The deposit will only be repaid if the child completes the 'Early Years' stage of their education (Reception) or the pupil starts and leaves at a later date. If refundable, the deposit will be repaid against the disbursements and extras on the child's final invoice.
